Ms. Dahl prepares, reviews and negotiates all forms of agreements, including confidentiality, employment, severance, asset purchase, materials transfer and development agreements. Ms. Dahl has successfully blocked the appointment of receivers and has prosecuted and defended hundreds of preference actions. Ms. Dahl has represented clients in diverse industries, including: clothing, chemicals, steel, plastics, auto parts, healthcare, pharmaceuticals, insurance, banking and financial services, construction, bedding, entertainment, and private equity.
